Donvale: Social stroll marks new Mullum Mullum Creek Trail

A community walk will be held at the weekend to mark the opening of a newly completed section of the Mullum Mullum Creek Trail.

Work to complete the 1.9-kilometre shared path that connects Park and Tindals roads in Donvale began in 2007.

The community walk will be introduced by historian and Friends of Mullum Mullum member Ken McInnes, and led by Steve Mathews, an environmentalist and Mullum Creek Estate member.

Part of the track weaves through land owned by the Mathews family.

Manningham mayor Jim Grivokostopoulos said the council had for years worked on finalising the trail with the Mathews family. "It has been a wonderful result," he said.

The completion of the Park and Tindals road section brings the city one step closer to finalising the entire Mullum Mullum Creek Trail network, which was endorsed by the former Doncaster and Templestowe Council in 1992.
