

Heads-up for construction

ROAD BASE

Please order recycled crushed concrete rather than virgin crushed rock

Now that construction has begun at Mullum Creek, the DRC would like to remind you to choose **crushed recycled concrete and/or other rubble** when you are ordering road base to spread on site for better construction vehicle access, as required on page 5 of the Mullum Creek Site and Waste Management Guide.

Recycling concrete and other hard waste for this purpose is almost certainly cheaper than producing virgin crushed rock, it does not have the environmental impacts associated with dedicated stone quarrying, it has good particle size distribution for excellent bedding and compaction, and it will cost you less.

We also strongly recommend that you spread road base only in areas where hard landscaping elements such as driveways will be finally located. This means that you won't need to remove it from site when construction is complete, which is terrific. Removing and recycling such spoil, once inevitably mixed with soil, would be difficult and expensive.
